

Privacy Policy for Gateway Interactive Websites

DATA

Gateway Interactive does not via its websites attempt to collect personal information such as your name, address, phone number or email address; unless this information is submitted by you via a specific information capture form. ACCESS

Information we have stored can be requested for deletion. You can contact us by methods detailed below to request to have this information deleted.

DELETION

Except where users have requested data deletion we may keep data indefinitely.

SHARING

We do not share personally identifiable information (such as name, address, email or phone) with other companies.

AD TRACKING

We do not allow advertising companies to collect data through our service for ad targeting.
